# to **Revelation** 20-22 (restoration)

Man again the earth, ruling forever, God with them

### Part 2 - The Kingdom Journey: How does God move from original plan in Genesis to restoration in Revelation?

Step 1 – Return The Land Through Abram/Abraham: A Man Who Loved God

Genesis 12:1-4, 7 - great nation, blessing, land

Genesis 13:14-18 - "all the land you see"

**Genesis 15:5-7, 18** - stars of the sky, land: "Nile to Euphrates"

Genesis 17:1-8 - "multiply exceedingly, nations & kings, land of Canaan"

**Genesis 22:15-18** - (post Isaac) - bless, multiply, descendants as stars/sand, possess gates of their enemies. God swears by himself that this will happen!

Land. Descendants. Blessing. (Opposite of cursing)

# Step 2 – Return The Rulership Through David: A Man Who Loved God 1 Chronicles 17:1 14 Davidio Covenant: Son of David. Son of Cod. King F.

1 Chronicles 17:1-14 - Davidic Covenant: Son of David, Son of God, King Forever

# Jeremiah 33:14-26 - Sureness of God's covenant promise

God's promise to David continues as long as sun and moon endure!

These two promises are realized in Jesus

Matthew 1:1 - son of God, son of David, son of Abraham

**Luke 1:26-35** - son of God, son of David, king forever

Galatians 3:26-29 - Abraham's children through faith in Christ.

But something is missing....

- God's original intention: man, on earth, with authority, IN RELATIONSHIP with him

## Step 3 – Return The Relationship Thought Jesus: The Son Of God

#### Romans 5:10-11 - Reconciliation

Merriam-Webster's (via m-w.com)

- 1: the act of causing two people or groups to become friendly again after an argument or disagreement.
- 2: the process of finding a way to make two different ideas, facts, etc., exist or be true at the same time.

Ephesians 2:12-13, 17-22 - Jesus brought us into the family of God, extends to us promises

Revelation 5:9-10 - Jesus buys us back! Makes us kings & priests to our God

• NAU: "purchased" ESV: "ransomed" KJV: "redeemed"

In Christ, the Abrahamic & Davidic Covenants are realized and the new covenant is made - bringing us back into right relationship with God!

To those who turn to Christ & follow him, he extends this Kingdom invitation to:

Revelation 2:7 – access to tree of life

Revelation 2:11 – not hurt by second death

**Revelation 2:26-28** – Jesus shares authority to rule the nations

Revelation 3:5 – not erased from book of life, confessed before the Father and angels

**Revelation 3:12** – pillar in the temple of God, part of the new city

Revelation 3:21 - sit on throne with Jesus and the Father
